WADAWANUCK SQUARE:



The Borough's largest park (1.6 acres) and home of the Stonington Free Library, which was dedicated in 1900. The square was the site of the Wadawanuck Hotel, which was built in 1837 to accommodate passengers traveling between Boston and New York via train and steamboat across Long Island Sound. The hotel was taken down in 1893 and the land gifted to the Borough by Heirs of Samuel Denison Babcock.
